The Sanskrit word Nakshatra means "that which does not decay." Nakshatra Garden is a perfect combination of astrology, Ayurveda, botany, and landscaping based on Indian mythology. There are 27 Nakshatras distributed over 12 months, and every Nakshatra has its own symbolic tree or plant and each plant has its own micro

biodiversity that defines the connection with eternal nature. It is believed that when such astral trees grow in their vicinity, we experience a positive atmosphere, spiritual solace, medication, rejuvenation, tranquillity, mental peace, and relaxation.
